Charge Policy

Student Meal Accounts

- Student meal accounts can be funded through multiple methods to include cash or check (see check acceptance below) and debit/credit card payment using online payment at www.k12paymentcenter.com.
- Each household is encouraged to complete a Free and Reduced Meal Application. This can be done online at www.lunchapplication.com or a paper application may be obtained at each school cafeteria or the Anderson One District Office and returned to the school cafeteria or to the Anderson One District Office. **Applications for the 2021-2022 school year can be submitted as early as July 12, 2021.**
- **You must send in a new meal application for the current school year, unless you received a new letter from Student Nutrition Services, stating that your child is eligible for free or reduced meals for the 2021-2022 school year.** If you do not send in a new meal application that is approved by the District Office at Anderson One, or you have not been notified that your child is eligible for free or reduced meals for the 2021-2022 school year, your child may not be eligible for any additional benefits that may be offered throughout the school year.
- **Any student transferring from a different school district must complete a new meal application for Anderson School District One.**

Meal Charges

- No a la carte or extra entrée charges will be allowed under any circumstances during the last ten days of school.
- Negative balances must be paid in full before the end of the school year.
- Unpaid meal charges should not exceed \$20.00 per student.
- The nutritional staff will be sending parents payment reminder letters, emails and phone calls.
- Teachers, adults or staff members will have a charge limit of \$20.00.

Check Acceptance Policy

- Your check is welcome at all schools in Anderson School District One. Anderson School District One recognizes that occasionally a check may be returned by your bank due to non-payment. In order to recover these funds in a private and professional manner, Anderson School District One has contracted with Envision Payment Solutions, for collection of returned checks. Universal Free Meals

- Each student is eligible to receive one free reimbursable breakfast and lunch per school day. Any additional items, meals or a la carte purchases will be charged to the student at the time of purchase.
